

Based on our belief that preserving the environment is one of the most important contemporary issues; an exclusive agency agree ment was signed with S.D.F GmbH company in Germany, to work on a solid waste recycling project that the company decided to implement in Jordan. The project aimed to convert the organic materials in the waste into fertilizer and energy, and Recycle and reuse of inorganic solid waste.

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#### Princess Sumaya University for Technology

We made an agreement with the training and consultation center at the University of Jordan, In order to discuss ways of cooperatio n in the field of training, it was agreed to conduct training courses in several areas, including holding English language diplomas that focused on improving reading, writing, listening and speaking skills, in addition to general and technical conversation writing courses.

These courses was given by native language speaker experts in teaching English to non-native speakers.

An agreement with Princess Sumaya University was signed, to discuss ways of cooperation in the field of training counselling, to make and arrange various courses and sessions in various fields, including conducting English language diplomas that focused on improving reading, writing, listening and speaking skills and preparation for the TOEFL and IELTS, in addition to general and technical conversation writing courses including all necessary language skills with a focus on communication and professional practice.

### Local and International Universities



#### **Al-Khawarzmi College**

Our partnership with Al-Khawarzmi College created numerous training opportunities for the youth and youth leaders, from different Jordanian governorates. Suggested topics included but not limited to renewable energy, Artificial Intelligence, Coding, Internet of things, learning engineering programs such as AutoCAD and Revit, graphic design programs such as 3D Max, Adobe Illustrator, Adobe Photoshop. Along with providing certified first aid workshops, life and management skills.

### *Employees* (training for employment project)



#### Sameh Mall

We signed an exclusive deal with Samah Mall in partnership with the Technical Vocational Academy for training and employment of new hires, which is funded by USAID. The goal of the project is to employ 1,000 unemployed individuals for the year of 2020 for the new branches of Sameh Mall, which are located in various cities in Jordan like Al-Mafraq, Al-Hoson, 7<sup>th</sup> Circle, and Sahab.

The training includes theoretical and practical learning, where there is a focus on safety and health, life skills, and interpersonal skills, as well as to how to create a hospitable work environment that fosters satisfaction and growth for all stakeholders.

Classic Fashion Apparel Industry Ltd. Co.

An agreement was signed with classic Fashion Apparel Industry Ltd. Co. to employ between 300 and 500 employees to work in sewing at their various. the training procedure divided into theoretical training and technical training. The theoretical training where the trainees receive life skills and safety and health trainings. The technical training where a supervisor trainer was provided by our organization and a trainer from the Traditional Fashion Company was present to train the trainees on how to us e the specific machinery the company uses so the trainees will be familiar with their machinery and equipment, while our supervisor and trainers evaluate their performance.

### **USAID TRAINING FOR EMPLOYMENT**

Human development programs funded by USAID and in cooperation with the Technical Vocational Training Academy.

The main purpose of the program to train and employ the Jordanian youth in addition to Syrian refugee in various occupational fields and for all ages and educational qualifications , to reduce the high unemployment rates among them.

We focused on giving the right training to make the trainees qualified to start the employment.

We made various partnerships with employers to put the program goal into action, and we trained and employed over 500 people in various fields in all Jordanian governate.

# **Retail Field** Training Program



Our partnership with Sameh Mall to train and employ their future employees in Sameh Mall branches in all governorates of the Kingdom, we train them in Life Skills and Effective communication skills To learn how to deal with clients, managers, and colleagues, and how to solve problems that may occur in the work environment beside time management skills. and also we trained them on occupational safety and health To avoid accidents that may occur in the work environment To avoid fire hazards and the risks of handling equipment and to qualify them to deal with these risks in a proper manner.

we trained and employed over **300 unemployed** in all **Sameh mall** branches in all Jordanian governate.

this training program is funded by the USAID and in cooperation with the Technical Vocational Training Academy.

























# **REHABILITATION** OF NEW TEACHERS

**The new teacher rehabilitation program** started on 01/07/2019 in partnership with several schools from different governorates around the Kingdom Jordan, such as Amman, Irbid, Al-Balqaa, and Ma'an. The program is in partnership with the Technical Vocational Academy and USAID which aims to train and refine new teachers to able to educate a new generation of learners.

The training focused on the **fundamentals of theoretical and behavioral learning** which is considered important knowledge for new teachers, as well as **practical teaching approach** of how to manage and control a room of new learners, **Passionate teaching, e-learning and blended learning methods** and **effective classroom management** and **present**ation skills, assessment and evaluation tools and techniques, and we trained them to Integrate technology in teaching so we trained them on using interactive smart board and other new technology. The training was supervised by experienced trainers.

we trained over **200 unemployed teachers** and employed over **150** in schools in **all Jordanian governate.** 

this training program is funded by the USAID and in cooperation with the Technical Vocational Training Academy.










# CAR MECHANIC TRAINING PROGRAM

Car mechanic program was held in 2019 in partnership with several car's garages in Al Balqa governorate in Ain Albasha and other governates . The program is funded by the USAID and in partnership with the Technical Vocational Academy, which aims to train youth to make them qualified to work as a car mechanic. The program ended on 30/04/2019. in addition to many car mechanics training programs.

We trained 50 unemployed people and employed 35 of them.

The training focused on **the fundamentals of theoretical and practical knowled ge of car mechanics** and provide the trainee with best training by training them in the work environment (on job training). Trainees underwent the following programs:

- General mechanical technician assistant.
- Auto electrical technician assistant.
- Car styling and paint technician.
- Hybrid cars maintenance
- Maintenance of cars that run on electricity
- Maintenance of cars running on gasoline
- Assembly of car's part like: antennas, radios, and batteries.



# **BEAUTY SERVICE** AND BARBER

In 2019 We signed an agreement deal with many Cultural Centers in both Jordanian governates Madaba and Irbid, which is in partnership with the Technical Vocational Academy for training and employment of new hires, funded by USAID, to train and employ unemployed youth on beauty services for women and barber for men, according to high rate of unemployed youth in these governate.

We trained **100 unemployed youth** and **80** of them became employees in saloons that we had an agreement with to employ our trainees.

The training programs focused on:

#### for women we trained them on:

- hair-cutting, colouring and styling
- Make-up
- waxing and other forms of hair removal
- nail treatments
- facials and skin care treatments

#### for men we trained them on:

- Hair: Cut and style, one step hair color, hair and scalp treatments
- Shaves: Traditional straight razor shaves
- Waxing Services: Eyebrow shaping



# ADMINSTATIVE TRAINING PROGRAM

In 2019 We signed an agreement deal with training Centers in many Jordanian governates like: Irbid and Amman, to train and employ unemployed youth on different administrative and vocational jobs, as part of USAID training for employment program in partnership with the Technical Vocational Academy.

We trained **90 unemployed youth** and **80** of them became employees in companies and working places that we had an agreement with to employ our trainees.



# NASHMIYAT KITCHEN PROJECT



The Nashmiyat Kitchen project in partnership with the Ministry of Labor, the Vocational Training Corporation and Safeway prepared a cooking workshop for women aged between 18 to 23, where they learned how to cook and perfect eastern and western cuisines, in addition to learning life skills and safety and health protocols to help them avoid accidents that can occur in work place, which was conducted in 2017 at our kitchen location in Safeway airport road branch.

# JORDAN UNIVERSITY ENGLISH DIPLOMA



During 2017, in collaboration with the training and consultation center at the University of Jordan, we also conducted an **English language diploma** courses, for **40 student** and **150 total training hours over a year**. Just like other similar courses, before starting; we ran a **level assessment test** to all students to identify areas of weakness and to know the level that the student should starts of, there are three level group: Beginners, intermediate and advanced.

Providing our students with **Cambridge and top notch English textbooks** that focus on the 4 main skills: **reading, writing, speaking and listening**, group works, conversations and class and homework. **This course was also given by native language speaker teachers Specialized in teaching English to non-native speakers.**

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


#### **English diploma**

There was two type of conversation clubs **general and technical conversation**.

#### **Technical writing courses**

We also conducted technical writing course and formal correspondence in English. This course develops **technical writing skills** necessary to communicate information gained through a process of technical or experimental work. The course highlights the factors that determine the degree of technicality of the language and concepts involved. You will learn how to write different technical reports, The course also approaches several language, structure, style, and content issues that you can encounter while reporting the results of your research. this course taught by **American native language speaker experienced ed in teaching English to non-native speakers.**

This workshop focused on the core concepts of **Lean management** to help them more efficiently increase value for customers, identify (and remove) ineffective activities, and continuously improve their processes by systematically implementing small changes. they learned how to implement Lean tools, techniques, and metrics for business.





# MEDIA COURSES

A training corse on **media basics and skills in radio and television** was held with the **trainer and journalist Naji Abu Luz** 

The course was for three weeks, in addition to a day of external shooting.

The course focused on professionally mastering the following skills:

- Television media skills, TV reporter work and TV story writing.
- The Voice Over and the skills of recording distinctive attractive sound and breaking barriers in the tension of the voice, coloring or shyness when standing in front of the camera and speaking boldly in front of it.
- Presentation skills in front of the public and the art of recitation.
- Television preparation for programs and reports.

The trainers trained in front of a TV camera. Their training included interviewing , a montage, audio recording, and a special TV report for each participant.









**Training of trainers (TOT) course** has been held in our company by training international experts and training consultants. This course in cooperation with **the Ministry of Youth and Arab Trainers Union,** to train the Jordanian youth on the strategies to manage and design youth activities.

This course aimed to provide practitioners with up-to-date adult learning techniques and methodologies that concentrate on the learner and on the proper facilitation of knowledge and experience exchange and sharing. The participants took a systematic approach to delivering training sessions that meet participants' needs as it gives them the access to practical tools, strategies, and techniques that make training dynamic, engaging, and effective. They also learned how to optimize their training environment and training programs to achieve outstanding learning results.

Presentation and presentation skills and body language- Training needs - Preparing training bags - Effective training methods and skills - Skills of dealing with trainees - Training evaluation


### "Psychological and Moral Support for Youth in the Light of the Corona Pandemic" WORKSHOP
